Honda Gx270 Engine Problems - How to Start Honda small engines Rant ON So after the problems starting the Honda GX270 engine on my pressure washer I decided to give them another chance and bought a log splitter with a Honda GX240 engine. Now it won't start, not even a hit of ignition. I must have pulled that rope 200 times. I think my Honda mower GX270 engine has a fuel flow problem and want to clean the carb. I have removed the air filter plastic mounting from its studs and exposed the carb throat. This gives rise to two questions. 1. the carb body is still tightly fixed. Honda's GC and GS engines use the world's first small engine internal timing belt, designed to last the lifetime of the engine. Small engine timing belts are usually external and are subject to wear caused by dirt. Honda's internal timing belt runs in oil, eliminating the need for conventional drive gears. This design:
